Information about the project:

EcoSwell is looking for a volunteer to support the implementation of their Renewable Energy project portfolio from September 2024 for three months. This portfolio includes several projects, the main ones are resilient medical centres in the City of Talara and other towns in the region (Nexans Foundation project), Solar Distiller design and building, improved cookstove design and building, offgrid household PV system installations and on-grid household energy education. Other initiatives also include PV system installations with the Fishermen Guild and in the EcoSwell house, among other projects.

Specific volunteer tasks

The volunteers will work with volunteer interns within the communities and ten members of EcoSwell staff. The tasks and responsibilities that the volunteers will carry out include:

- Work with EcoSwell Director to continuously refine the strategic goals of our renewable energy projects.
- Keep an accurate account of all active and future EcoSwell renewable energy projects.
- Report weekly to EcoSwell Director on progress made
- Plan tasks and next steps for each project.
- Lead a team of volunteer interns in Lobitos to ensure projects are progressing
- Manage proper reporting and budgeting of projects
- Liaising with project sponsors and suppliers
- Liaising with community partners and members during project implementation
- Ensuring volunteer interns are abiding by safety protocols and procedures
- Proposing improvements to designs, projects and processes
- Ensuring the creation of marketing content of our renewable energy projects
